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LINDBERGH BRIDGE DEMOLITION SCHEDULED

On August 19, 2022, starting at 9 p.m. until August 22, 2022 at 5 a.m., all eastbound and westbound I-270 traffic will detour at Lindbergh. This will allow crews to demolish the old bridge over I-270 North.

CURRENT AND UPCOMING WORK AREAS:

- Old Halls Ferry Road on ramp to close for 14 days starting 8/15.
- Restriping westbound I-270 through Coldwater Creek will take place on 8/18 & 8/21.
- MoDOT will close all northbound and southbound lanes on New Halls Ferry Road between Dunn Road and Pershall Road between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. on both Thursday, August 18 and Friday, August 19.
- I-270 full closure for Lindbergh bridge demolition on 8/19.
- Eastbound I-270 exit to New Florissant Road to close for 45 days on 8/29.
- New eastbound on ramp from Pershall Road/ Washington Street to open on 8/29.
- The existing eastbound on ramp from Washington Street/ Elizabeth Avenue to close on 8/29.
- Eastbound exit to West Florissant Road to close for 60 days on 8/29.
